FREE FREE FREE

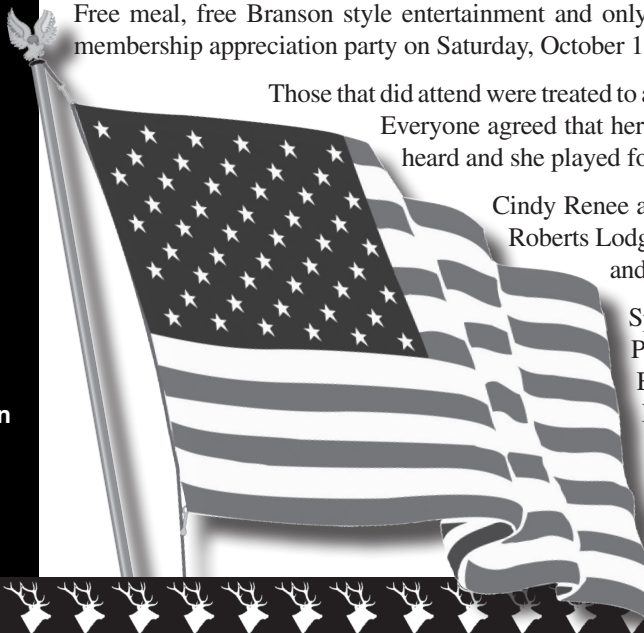
What part of FREE did some of our members not understand?

This is an opportunity to help residents of the community and to continue to prove that "Elks Care-Elks Share".

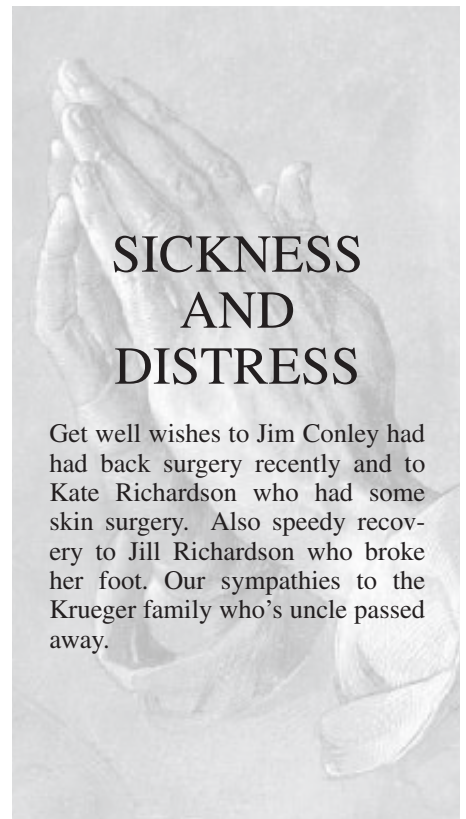
